INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Use scissors to cut the NCR paper pattern down so it's easier to transfer onto the piece.
- 2. Place the NCR paper pattern on top of the plate and firmly trace over the lines using a ballpoint pen. You don't need to trace the letters now; we will trace them later.
- 3. Use a liner brush to apply a thin line of Red Hot to the edge of the tin. If helpful, use the photo as a reference.
- 4. Paint the tin lid (painting around the water) with three generous coats of Gecko Green.
- 5. Fill in the water section with three generous coats of Deep Sea.
- 6. Next, fill the fish in the water section with three coats of Blush.
- 7. Using the photo as a guide, use a liner brush to apply three generous coats of Sea Mist to the bottom section of the tin.
- 8. When the top of the plate is dry, use the NCR pattern to trace on the lettering.
- 9. Use a detail brush to apply the letters on the lid with Red Hot and Saffire. Then, the letters on the bottom with Pumpkin Pie.
- 10. Finally, dip the end of the detail brush into Saffire and tap a tiny dot on each fish for the eye.


TIPS

- Apply three generous coats of paint in order to get solid colors.
- When using the liner brush, you can thin down the paint slightly to help the lines flow more easily.
